Young Professionals in Energy (“YPE”) is the first and only inter-disciplinary networking and volunteer organization for young professionals in the global energy industry – a place where bankers can connect with engineers, accountants with geologists, and investors with lobbyists. YPE’s mission is to provide a forum for knowledge sharing and camaraderie among future leaders in the energy industry.

Who is a member of YPE?

YPE seeks involvement from a broad base of professionals working in the energy industry. Engineers, geoscientists, landmen, financial analysts, research analysts, lobbyists, government employees, accountants, attorneys, commercial and investment bankers, principal investors, consultants, and anyone else with a direct professional focus on the energy sector are encouraged to join YPE.

Program Events

YPE hosts events on a regular basis in 18 energy hubs around the world for its members. Events range from happy hours, to the YPE Speaker Series, to social mixers in connection with the major industry conferences such as CERA Week and OTC. Whether it’s a financial modeling boot camp, a facility site visit or a charity golf tournament, YPE looks for creative ways to bring together young people in the energy industry.
